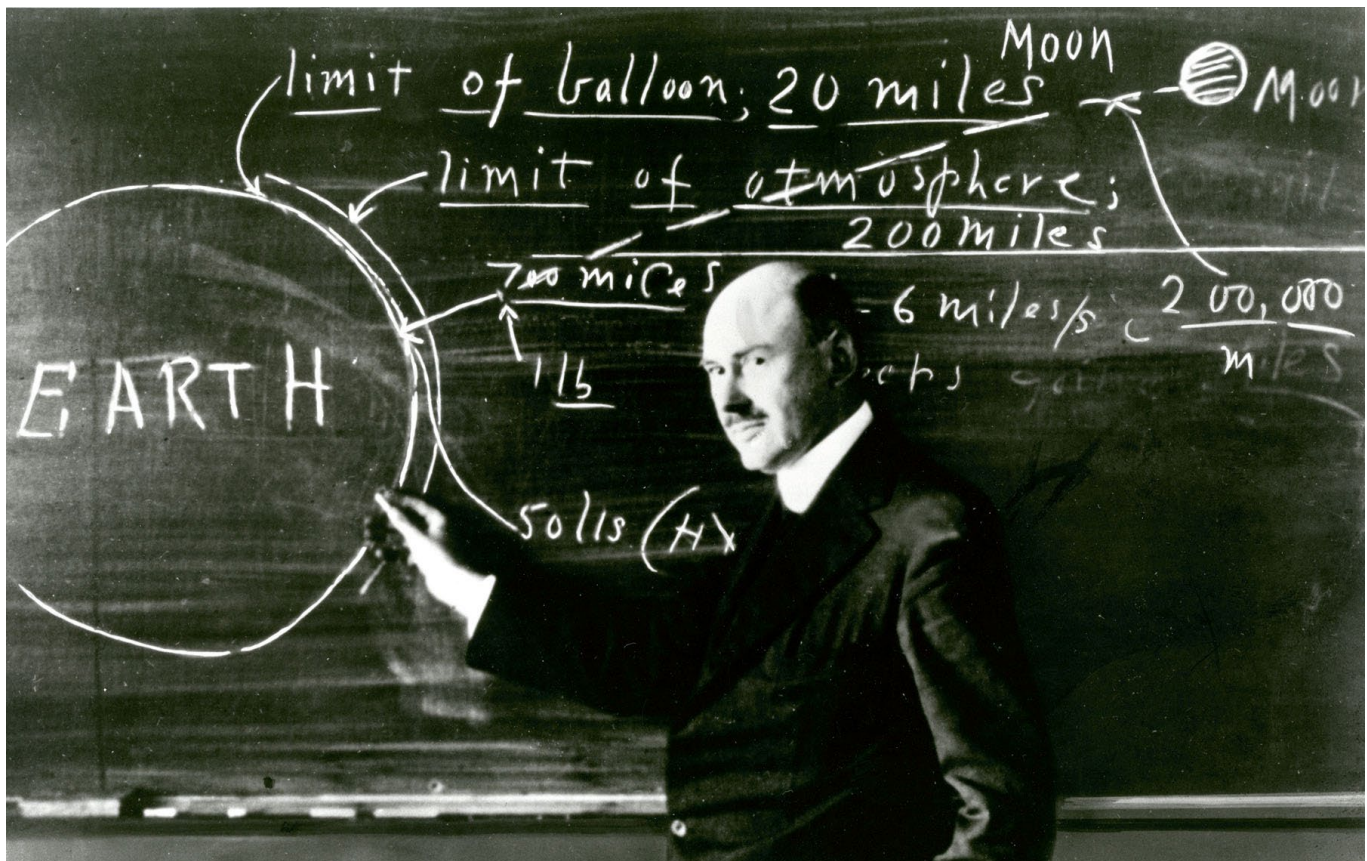




Zoom Colloquium – Monday March 16th, 7:00 PM ET

Robert Goddard, Father of Modern Rocketry

Commemorating the 100th Anniversary of the First Liquid-Fueled Rocket Launch, March 16th, 1926



On March 16, 1926, Robert Goddard successfully completed the first liquid-fueled rocket launch, a brief flight that forever changed the trajectory of space exploration. Please join the AIAA Niagara Frontier Section this month for a commemoration of the achievements of Dr. Goddard on the 100th anniversary, to the day, of that first launch. The program will open with remarks by **The Hon. Chris Scolese**, Director of the National Reconnaissance Office and former Director of NASA's Goddard Space Flight Center. Dr. Scolese will introduce **Dr. Bill Barry**, immediate past NASA Chief Historian, who will explore how the historical perception of Goddard has evolved over the last century. The keynote address on Goddard and his achievements will be delivered by **Dr. Richard Hallion**, preeminent aerospace historian, prolific author, and former Chief Historian of the U.S. Air Force.
